You will be required to register with the VA Volunteer Services (VAVS) at the Hampton VAMC which requires completing a background check. You will be required to perform duties outdoors during all types of weather conditions. You will be asked to perform rifle salutes during certain ceremonies, such as on Memorial Day.
